**SUBJECT: Additional Information for Materials License No. 21-24692-01 (Verso Paper)
Docket No. 030-29166 and Control No. 630248**

On February 28, 2022, Verso Paper (“Applicant”) submitted an application (“Application”) to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (“NRC”) to renew Materials License No. 21-24692-01.¹ In response to discussions with the NRC staff arising from a transfer of control (consented to by letter dated March 28, 2022²), Verso Paper hereby provides the following additional information in support of the Application:

- Verso Paper should be identified as Verso Quinnesec LLC, which is the wholly owned, wholly controlled indirect subsidiary of Billerud Americas Corporation (formerly known as Verso Corporation) that owns the mill at which licensed activities pursuant to Materials License No. 21-24692-01 are performed. Verso Quinnesec LLC is registered with the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs’ Corporations Division to do business in Michigan.
- Verso Quinnesec LLC will undergo a name change, to be effective on or about July 1, 2022, which should be reflected on the license. The new entity name is Billerud Quinnesec LLC.
- No other information in the Application is affected by the additional information provided herein. All other information remains true and correct to the best of the Applicant’s knowledge and belief.


