The Homestake Mining Company of California (HMC) submitted its Fourth Amendment to the Standby Trust Agreement (STA) to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) in a letter dated March 25, 2022 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) ML22087A078). In the cover letter, HMC stated the enclosed package includes, "2. Revised Standby Trust Agreement (NRC signature required)". The first paragraph in the Fourth Amendment to the STA includes the following language:

FOURTH AMENDMENT TO THE STANDBY TRUST AGREEMENT, dated as of ______, 2022 ("FOURTH AMENDMENT") among Homestake Mining

Company of California, a California corporation, Citibank, N.A., a national bank, and U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

The staff notes the date line, "dated as of ______, 2022", is blank. It is NRC staff's understanding, after discussions with HMC staff, that the final signatory (the NRC staff member with signature authority) should date the blank date line when signing the STA. This was unclear to the NRC staff. The NRC staff requests confirmation from HMC that the final signatory of the STA, the NRC staff member with signature authority, is expected to date the STA.
