In response to your email dated May 27, 2022, the following information is being supplied in support of our license renewal request for 45-08890-02.

As stated in our telephone conversation, and by email, F&R currently owns 143 nuclear density gauges, none of which are housed / stored in your jurisdiction. We do, however, work on Federal property, military bases and in the District of Columbia as temporary project sites.

With the above in mind, F&R would like to request our license to cover all our existing units, with a little range for increase, as follows:

Troxler 4640	5 units
InstroTek 3500, Humboldt 5001 and Troxler 3216	30 units
Troxler 3400 series	125 units

Highly unlikely we will ever have all our gauges within your jurisdiction at any one time, but these numbers would cover what we own "if lightning strikes".
