We are sending this letter to inform the Nuclear Regulatory Commission that no rulemaking is required for the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to satisfy the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) Procedure SA-200 for Regulation Action Tracking System (RATS) number 2020-3 (Miscellaneous Corrections).

RATS number 2020-3 is solely the responsibility of the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). The crosswalk is attached. We have discussed this with our counterpart at DSHS and they agree.
