Dear Mr. Baumer:

This refers to the license renewal application dated January 6, 2022 for St. Louis Testing Laboratories, Inc., NRC License No. 24-00188-02. We reviewed the application in accordance with NUREG-1556, Volume 2, Revision 1 and Volume 20, Revision 1. Based on the review, we determined that your renewal application was not prepared in accordance with the licensing guidance in NUREG-1556, Volume 2, Revision 1. Specifically, information for Items 5 through 11 listed in the application (NRC Form 313) were not provided.

Please review NUREG-1556, Volume 2, Revision 1 which can be downloaded from the NRC website at <https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1556/v2/index.html> and provide the information as discussed in Appendix C, "Suggested Format for Providing Information Requested in Items 5 through 11 of U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Form 313". A pdf copy of Appendix C is attached for your reference.

To continue the review of your application, we request that you submit your response under a dated and signed cover letter by March 14, 2022. In the cover letter, please refer to the license number, docket number and Mail Control No. 629857. We will assume that you do not wish to further pursue this licensing action if we do not receive the response within the specified timeframe noted above.
