This email formally acknowledges receipt of the letter from Mistras Group dated April 20, 2022 in response to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) letter dated March 24, 2022, transmitting a Notice of Violation. In this letter, and in supplemental correspondence provided on May 27, 2022, you identified the root causes and contributing factors for the violation of 10 CFR 34.31(a), as well as the corrective actions that your company has taken and plans to take to address the violation.
