Eli Lilly and Company (Lilly) herein provides comment on the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) request for comment published in the April 28, 2022 Federal Register Notice for the NRC Docket No. NR-2017-0031 Regulatory Basis (Decommissioning Financial Assurance Requirements for Sealed and Unsealed Radioactive Materials).

Lilly supports Alternative 2 that the NRC selected as the preferred option. Alternative 2 from the NRC document would update the list of radionuclides and values in Appendix B to 10 CFR Part 30 Tables. The use of nuclides such as Ge-68 in medicine was unknown when the NRC tables were originally developed. These tables need updated to reflect the increasing use of these newer nuclides.
