Dear Mr. Hadden:

In your letter dated April 26, 2022, you requested a license amendment to NRC License No. 45-25221-01MD. In order to continue our review, please provide the following additional information:

1. Your letter had a “font” signature, rather than a digital or wet (hard copy) signature. All amendment requests and licensing commitments require an actual signature.

Please submit a signed letter, and confirm that all statements made in your letter dated April 26, 2022 are accurate.

2. You requested to name Devin Woods, R.Ph. and William Crisp, R.Ph. as authorized nuclear pharmacists (ANPs).
 - a. I confirmed that “Devin R. Woods” and “William Ira Crisp, II” are registered pharmacists in the State of Missouri. Please confirm “William Ira Crisp” and “William Ira Crisp, II” are the same person.
 - b. Please confirm that both Mr. Woods and Mr. Crisp will only be working at your Missouri location. Alternatively, you may submit copies of their pharmacist registrations from the State of West Virginia.
 - c. Mr. Woods and Mr. Crisp are both listed as Pharm.D. on the provided Virginia and Texas radioactive licenses. Please confirm that Mr. Woods and Mr. Crisp should both be listed on the license as a Pharm.D. (instead of R.Ph.).

We will continue our review upon receipt of the requested information. You may respond to my attention in writing by letter, email (if letter is signed by senior management and scanned into a pdf format), or fax (610-337-5269), referencing mail control number 631255. Please submit a reply within by July 19, 2022, or we will assume you no longer wish to pursue this amendment.
