The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) received a license application from Holtec International (Holtec) to construct and operate a consolidated interim storage facility for spent nuclear fuel in Lea County, New Mexico. The NRC has recently issued the final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) for the proposed project. We are requesting that the Roswell Public Library add this to the information previously sent for public review.
