dosages of technetium-99m (Tc-99m) radiophannaceuticals that did not fall within the prescribed dosage range.						
Specifically, on both occasions the licensee administered 37.5 millicuries (mCi) of Tc-99m when the range was 24 to 36 mCi, and was not otherwise directed to do so by an authorized user.

As corrective action for this Severity Level IV violation, the inspector discussed the finding and the						
requirement with the licensee's technologist and with its consultant. The technologist committed to being more						
diligent in ensuring that doses fell within the prescribed dosage range prior to administration, and the consultant committed to discussing the findings and the regulatory requirement with the technologist.
