All,

As a result of our discussion yesterday, I understand the following:

- You have a contract with a Dade Moeller/NV5 for surveys of your facilities. Clark Barton will be developing a written historical site assessment and planning the final status survey of the buildings in which American Ordnance received DU cores, clad for assembly [only a small opening with access to core], and assembled them into finished munitions
- Based on the historical information already gathered and discussed during the meeting, all areas are MARSSIM Class 3, expected to be below the criteria for release. However, surveys done at the time of such assembly (several decades ago) were not at the sensitivity required at this time for release for unrestricted use.
- The final status survey will use NRC screening values for release. I am attaching the federal register notices that indicate those screening values, although references to these can be found in the NUREG 1757 series.
- Based on the above, and a review of the license and decommissioning regulations, you are not required to submit a Decommissioning Plan for this. You always have the option to submit a DP, however, to ensure that the NRC is in agreement with your plan prior to implementation.

If any of my understandings are incorrect, please let me know. A copy of this email will be placed into ADAMS as part of the licensing action for decommissioning and termination of the American Ordnance license.
