Three.

**2. If you are unable to answer the previous question based on the M-19-19 definition, how many federal data centers does your agency currently operate following the most up to date Integrated Data Collection guidance?**

Eight, including three Tiered and five non-Tiered data centers.

**i. If no, please explain why and provide the timeline expected to complete data center closures.**

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has one remaining Tiered data center that is not a key mission facility. The NRC plans to continue to reduce operating costs by closing this data center. The NRC continues to migrate systems to the Cloud and our co-location facility. The closure of this data center is scheduled to be completed by the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of fiscal year 2026.
