NOTICE OF CHANGE OF CONTROL

Please be advised that effective on or about September 1, 2022, North Ottawa Community Hospital ("North Ottawa" or the "Facility"), currently a Michigan nonprofit directorship corporation without a corporate member and under the control of a board of trustees, will convert to a Michigan nonprofit membership corporation with Mercy Health Partners, a Michigan nonprofit corporation, as its sole corporate member ("Mercy Health"). Mercy Health in turn is a wholly owned subsidiary of Trinity Health-Michigan, a Michigan nonprofit corporation.

North Ottawa is a hospital in Grand Haven, Michigan and is the holder of the following Materials License and will continue to hold the Materials License under the same tax identification number following the change of control:

North Ottawa Community Hospital, Materials License No. 21-13963-01

As of the effective date of the change of control, the name of the Facility will be changed to Trinity Health Grand Haven Hospital. In addition, although Mercy Health will appoint new members to the Facility's board of trustees as a result of the change of control, two of the current members of the Facility's board will continue to serve on the Facility's board for at least three years following the change of control.

There are no plans to change the operations of the Facility and no personnel changes are anticipated at this time. There will be no changes in the location, facilities, equipment, radiation safety program or procedures that relate to the licensed program.

All necessary surveillance of the Facility has been performed, documented, and reviewed prior to the consummation of this transaction and will be current as of the effective date of the change of control.

All records will be transferred to the new ownership of the Facility when the ownership of the entire Facility transfers with an anticipated effective date of September 1, 2022. The

records will stay in the same location and maintenance policies for all records will not change following the transaction.

No current decommissioning funding plans or other financial assurance documents will change as a result of the change in control.

All records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the Facility will be transferred to Mercy Health and will continue to be maintained by the Facility.

North Ottawa and Mercy Health agree to the change of control described in this notice and to the conditions of transfer. While there are currently no open inspection items, should any arise, North Ottawa and Mercy Health accept responsibility for possible resulting enforcement actions that may arise out of future open inspection items.

The new owner of the Facility, Mercy Health, commits to maintain all of the records received in accordance with all governmental requirements. Mercy Health agrees to abide by all constraints, license conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments in the currently issued Materials License.

Mercy Health is not aware of any contamination of the Facility or open inspection and enforcement issues disclosed to it by North Ottawa and North Ottawa represents that it is not aware of any contamination of the Facility or open inspection and enforcement issues associated with its Materials License.


Please consider this letter to be notice of the change in the ownership and name of the Facility and to serve as a request for the written consent from the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission pursuant to 10 CFR 30.34(b) for the transfer of control of the Facility and its Materials License No. 21-13963-01.

It is our understanding that no further action on the part of the Facility is required for the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission to issue its consent to the change of control of the Materials License.
