Dear Mr. Wimmer:

In letter dated July 11, 2022, you notified the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of a request to terminate NRC Materials License No. 24-02564-02. Your letter is available electronically from the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession No. ML22193A241. The NRC's ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web site at https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html.

The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys. Based on its review, the NRC staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the facility and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions are required with respect to NRC-regulated material. Your facilities are suitable for unrestricted use, and NRC Materials License No. 24-02564-02 is hereby terminated. (See Enclosure for the amended license stating that the license is terminated.)
