Pursuant to the requirements set forth by 10 CFR 40.35(f), Honeywell Metropolis Works hereby submits the updated Honeywell Metropolis Works Emergency Response Plan (ERP). This submittal incorporates changes made to the ERP on 2/9/2022. The change reflects the current activities associated with the preparation of the plant for eventual start-up in calendar year 2023. Prior to the completion of restart activities Honeywell will implement an ERP that is equivalent to revision 9 of the ERP.

Per 10 CFR 40.35(f), "the licensee may change the plan without Commission approval, if the changes do not decrease the effectiveness of the plan." These ERP changes were evaluated using Honeywell's configuration management process as not requiring prior NRC approval for the reason that they do not decrease the effectiveness of the Plan.

Pursuant to the procedures set forth in NRC Regulatory Issue Summary 2005-31 pertaining to submitting security-related sensitive information, the enclosed submitted herewith shall be withheld under 10 CFR 2.390 as security-related sensitive information.
