On May 18, 2022, you agreed to perfect the remainder of Item 9 in your request. Item 9 was "all documents referenced in
the Office of the Inspector General investigative report issued on March 6, 2014 entitled "NRC Oversight of
Decommissioning Activities at the Shallow Land Disposal Area Consistent with USACE MOU," from OIG Case No. 12-59,
attached as Exhibit C in your request.
