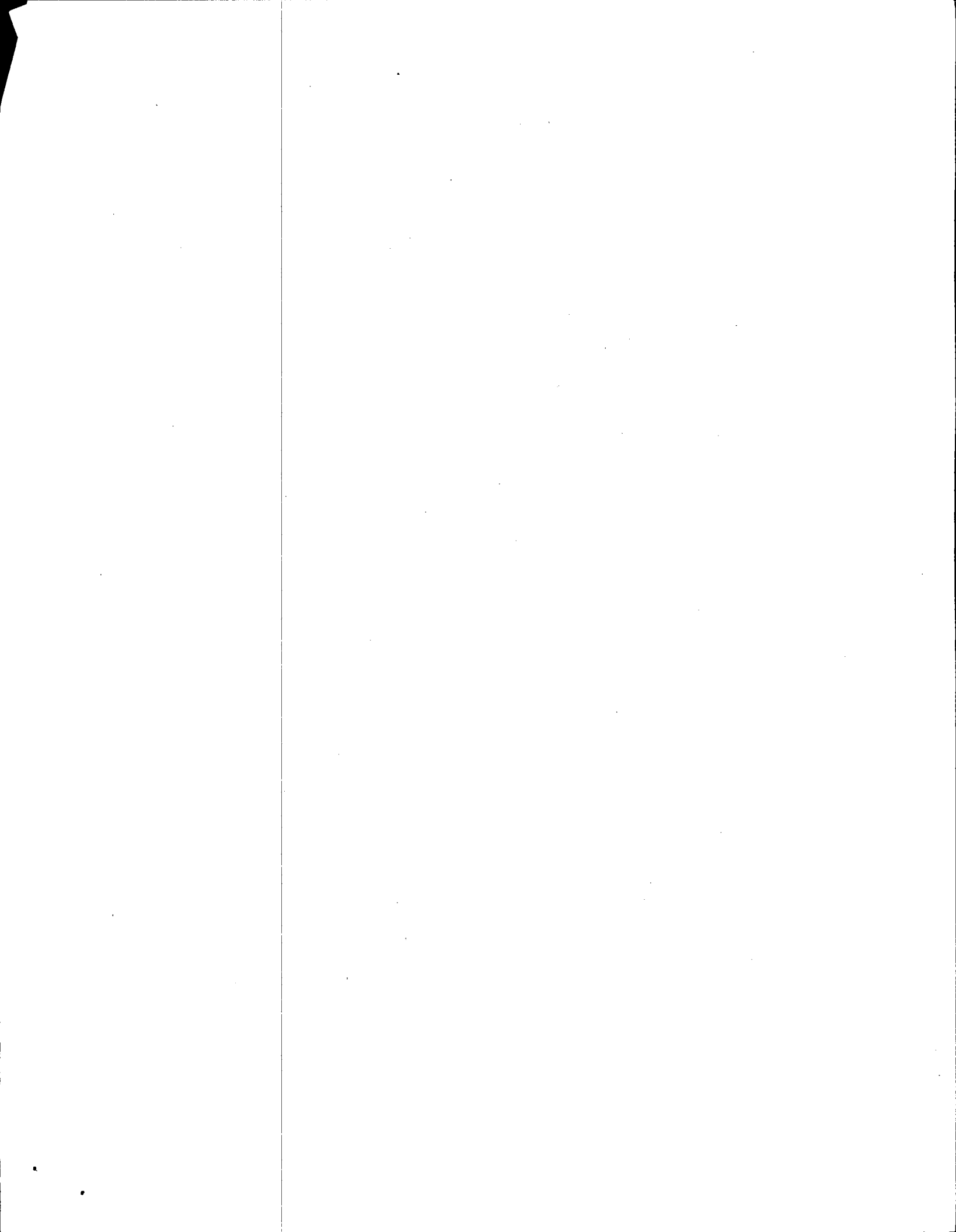

SECY-A-77-65B REVISED DRAFT ORDER RE
PETITIONS IN BAILLY CP

MR. CHILK: This is SECY-A-77-65B, the subject is a Revised Draft Order for the Commission Disposition For Petitions for the Review or the Denial by the Director of NRR of Request to Initiate Proceeding for the Suspension and Revocation of the Bailly Construction Permit.

You will recall that some time ago the Commission was petitioned to review this determination by the Director of NRR to deny a request for the initiation proceedings to suspend and revoke a construction permit issued to the Northern Indiana Public Service Company to construct the Bailly generating station and subsequently you got identical petitions from others. The petitioners made various assertions which the General Counsel has counter. The General Counsel has recommended that the petition be denied.

What we are asking you to affirm today is the

1 petition which is attached to SECY-A-77-65B with the addition
2 of a Footnote which was given to you by the General Counsel
3 in which he coordinated with all of your offices.
