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2 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: There is an affirmation item
3 which I would like to do. And the first step for that
4 affirmation item is to note that it was not listed on the
5 agenda.

6 Do you want to outline it, John, in 30 seconds or
7 less? We have all agreed on it.

8 MR. HOYLE: The item, Mr. Chairman, is a Memorandum
9 of Understanding between the NRC and the Department of Energy
10 which is a superseding Memo of Understanding to the March 11
11 one of last year that was signed by Chairman Rowden and
12 Acting Administrator Frye.

13 Essentially, it updates changing ERDA to the
14 Department of Energy in every instance and revising the
15 section on ACRS access by the Department of Energy.

16 I do have all of your individual votes for this
17 item, but in order to affirm it, we do need a vote first to
18 have this item and vote on it on short notice.

19 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Yes.

20 If you would, please, I would ask for your affir-
21 mative vote then to hold a short-notice affirmation vote on
22 this Memorandum of Understanding.

23 (Hands were raised.)

24 So ordered.

25 And I would then ask for your affirming vote on

1 Memorandum of Understanding.

2 MR. HOYLE: With one change, Mr. Chairman.

3 On page 4, we have deleted from the footnote at the
4 suggestion of Commissioner Bradford a reference to the ECC
5 bypass test facility.

6 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Fine.

7 MR. HOYLE: As an example of facilities.

8 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Okay, those in favor?

9 (Hands were raised.)

10 So ordered.

11 Good. That means that it is signed with a clear
12 conscience and a knowledge that the responsibility is shared
13 from across the whole panel tomorrow afternoon.

14 Any other items?

15 (No response.)
