P R O C E E D I N G S

2 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Okay, the Commission will gather
3 its strength and lurch forward into affirming a few things.

4 Mr. Chilk, would you lead us?

5 MR. CHILK: Yes, sir.

6 The first one is SECY-78-161, which is a subsidiary
7 arrangements to the US/IAEA Safeguards Agreement and to
8 obtain Commission approval of the subsidiary arrangements
9 and the transitional subsidiary arrangements to implement
10 the US/IAEA Safeguards Agreement.

11 Both the agreement and the protocol require specific
12 arrangements to be made, indicating how these things will be
13 applied. The paper indicates that the arrangements have been
14 completed between the U.S. and IAEA team with the exception
15 of one minor revision.

16 The paper before you outlines the key provisions
17 of the agreement and recommended that the Commission approve
18 the subsidiary arrangements and the transitional subsidiary
19 arrangements.

20 All of you have concurred with the exception of
21 Mr. Gilinsky who is not present who noted without objection.

22 I ask you for an affirmative vote.

23 (Chorus of "ayes.")

24 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: So ordered.

25 MR. KENNEDY: This is the paper 78-161.

1 MR. CHILK: That's right.

2 MR. KENNEDY: I remain somewhat confused about the
3 status then of 78-162.

4 MR. CHILK: I have to check that for you, Commis-
5 sioner.

6 MR. KENNEDY: Which is Implementation of Inter-
7 national Atomic Energy Agency Safeguards Requirments, which
8 is obviously related to and maybe even underlies --

9 MR. CHILK: I will check that out and report back
10 to you this afternoon.

11 MR. KENNEDY: Thank you.

12 MR. CHILK: The second affirmation is a proposed
13 Order Denying the EXXON Petition relating to reconsideration
14 of the Commission's GESMO Decision. The order was dis-
15 tributed to all of you yesterday and the day before. And
16 it is my understanding everybody has concurred in that order.

17 I ask you now to affirm.

18 (Chorus of "ayes.")

19 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: So ordered.

20 And we have struck Item B from the list.

21 MR. CHILK: We have struck Item B from the list,
22 that's right.

23 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: The list of items.

24 I thank you all very much.
