Mr. Villarreal and Mr. Fizette,

I understand that Jason Draper performed an inspection during the week of July 24, and he discussed the need for you to complete the renewal of your license by committing to the procedures in NUREG-1556, Volume 1, **Revision 2** for portable gauges. Here is the link, and I am attaching a copy.

Please note that this has been requested multiple times; first in a letter dated October 15, 2021 from Sara Forster, and a letter dated June 30, 2020 from me, as well as additional email. The most recent request was July 27, 2022 email, correcting a statement I had made in an earlier email. We can no longer accept commitments to Revision 1, because that was superseded in 2016 by Revision 2.

In addition, Jason informed me that Mr. Villareal has been performing most of the activities related to licensing of the portable gauges. At the moment, Mr. Fizette is listed in our database as the official contact for licensing. If the licensing contact should be changed, please let me know at the same time as you provide the commitments to Revision 2.
