Dear April Hammond –

The attached letter refers to the routine inspection that was conducted at your facility in Great Falls, Montana on March 16, 2022. Based on the results of this inspection, two apparent violations were identified and are being considered for escalated enforcement. Dr. Katanic discussed these preliminary findings with you during the exit briefing on August 16, 2022. Before the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission makes a decision, we are providing you an opportunity to: (1) respond in writing, (2) request a predecisional enforcement conference; or (3) request alternative dispute resolution. Please contact me at 817-200-1455 or via email within 10 days of the date of this letter with your decision on how you will choose to respond to the apparent violations.
