Dear Mr. Hessler:

This is in reference to your application and letter dated June 30, 2021, requesting to renew NRC License No. 21-18673-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. The application and letter stated that Les Hartford would be the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO), until Christopher Hessler completed the RSO training. Confirm if Les Hartford will remain the RSO, or provide documentation of completion of training for Christopher Hessler or another individual.
2. The company name listed on the current license is Gerdau Monroe Mill. The company name listed on the application is Gerdau Macsteel Monroe Mill; and the company name on the letter is Gerdau Special Steel North America Monroe. Please confirm the correct name which should be listed on the license. If the change of name is due to a transfer of the license or company, as described in NUREG-1556, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses," Volume 15, "Guidance About Changes of Control and About Bankruptcy Involving Byproduct, Source, or Special Nuclear materials License," Revision 1 (NUREG-1556, vol. 15, Rev.1), review Chapter 5 and Appendices C and D, and provide the information requested in Appendix E, "Information Needed for Transfer of Control Application." 3. The application names a new authorized user, Andrew Hansen. Please provide documentation of his training to be an authorized user. Alternately, in accordance with NUREG-1556, Volume 4, "Program Specific Guidance About Fixed Gauge Licenses," Revision 1 (NUREG-1556, Vol. 4, Rev. 1), you may state "Before using licensed materials, authorized users will have successfully completed one of the training courses described in the 'Criteria' part of the section titled 'Authorized Users' in NUREG-1556, Vol. 4, Rev. 1. This commitment would provide relief from submitting names and qualification information for authorized users." <https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1556/v4/index.html>
4. Given the length of time since the renewal application was submitted, please include any other pertinent changes to the application at this time.

In order to continue prompt review of your application, we request that you submit your response to this letter within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter.
