16. Scope and Observations:

This was an announced, routine inspection of several field offices of Ascension St. Vincent Hospital in Indiana. The inspector visited: 1) 23rd St., Bedford location that had one Nuclear Medicine Technologist (NMT) who came twice a month on Saturdays and performed 10 diagnostic procedures, 2) Epworth Crossing, Newburgh location where only Tc-99 breast lymphoseek injections were perform by an authorized user, approximately 3 per month, 3) Millis Ave., Boonville where the nuclear department was staffed with one NMT who performed six cardiac studies on Tuesdays and Fridays, and 4) St. Mary's Dr., Evansville location that had 6 NMTs who performed 14 cardiac procedures per day, 12 PET procedures per week, and 29 Y-90 procedures per year; at this location, the inspector also visited Lab 3, where Y-90 is administered, and interviewed the staff and performed surveys.

PERFORMANCE OBSERVATIONS

The inspector conducted a tour of all the nuclear medicine departments and discussed with the NMTs package receipt, surveys, and instrument quality control checks. The inspector observed the preparation and administration of a variety of diagnostic procedures during this inspection week. The NMT demonstrated adequate knowledge of radiation safety principles and practices through interviews. The inspector reviewed audit reports, written directives, instruments calibration, inventory, surveys, wipes, leak test, and training. The inspector also reviewed monthly dosimetry reports which indicated annual whole-body and extremity doses were below regulatory limits.

No violations of NRC requirements were identified as a result of this inspection.
