SUBJECT: CANCELLATION AND RETURN OF FINACIAL ASSURANCE INSTRUMENT
FOR LICENSE NO. SUA-1139

Dear Dan Grapski:

By email dated September 8, 2022¹, the ExxonMobil Corporation (Exxon) requested the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) cancel and return the financial assurance instrument, which Exxon provided to the NRC with respect to Exxon's NRC License No. SUA-1139 for the Highland Reclamation Project.

Exxon is no longer required to maintain financial assurance with respect to this NRC license as licensing authority has been transferred to the State of Wyoming, Department of Environmental Quality (WDEQ). By email dated September 17, 2021 and its attached letter from the WDEQ², WDEQ accepted Exxon's Surety Bond in the amount of \$1,430,000 for the WDEQ permit. Therefore, NRC is cancelling and returning the financial assurance instruments that were provided to NRC for the Highland Reclamation Project. The cancelled Surety Bond and cancelled Standby Trust Agreement are enclosed.
