Ms. Updike:

I have reviewed the license application dated July 5, 2022, for the renewal of U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Materials License No. 13-32393-01 (The South Bend Clinic). I identified the below items that require additional or clarifying information:

1. A check with the Indiana Secretary of State's Corporations Division was not able to successful in confirming the active registration of *THE SOUTH BEND CLINIC*. Though, a similar registration was located for *THE SOUTH BEND CLINIC, LLC*. Please confirm that the full legal name of the licensee is *THE SOUTH BEND CLINIC, LLC*.
2. Your request identifies that a Ludlum Model 14C GM Survey Meter is available. Please identify the manufacturer and model number of the probe(s) that are available at the licensed facility for use with this survey meter. In addition, please confirm that an equivalent survey meter will be available when this survey meter is sent out for calibration and/or repair.
3. I understand that you serve as the Radiation Safety Officer for the licensee on a consulting basis. As requested in Section 8.7.1 of NUREG-1556, Volume 9, Rev. 3, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance About Medical Use Licenses," please elaborate on your overall availability to respond to questions or operational issues that may arise during the conduct of the radiation safety program and related regulatory requirements. You identified that the maximum amount of time required for you to report the licensed facility would vary. In this case, please provide a conversative estimate of the maximum amount of time required for you to arrive at the facility in the event of an emergency that requires your physical presence. Please also identify an in-house representative who will serve as the point of contact during your absence.

Please respond to this request within 15 calendar days. In the response, please reference U.S. NRC Materials License No. 13-32393-01 and Control Number 631731 to ensure proper routing. You're welcome to submit the response letter directly to me via e-mail, but I recommend that you request an e-mail receipt or other acknowledgement that the response has been received.
