Enclosed is a copy of the revisions to the proposed State of Nebraska Radiological Health, Title 180 Nebraska Administrative Code (NAC) Control of Radiation. Proposed revisions will soon be made available for public comment with a request for comments within five business days of the public hearing which is being held on October 31, 2022 for 180 NAC 5 and 7, and November 2, 2022 for 180 NAC 14 and 19. The proposed regulations are identified by highlighted line-in/line-out text in the attached draft regulations and correspond to the following equivalent amendments to NRC's regulations:


