

LICENSE CONDITION 17, AMENDMENT 13, DATED 3/3/2022, REQUIRES THAT EACH PORTABLE GAUGE HAVE A LOCK ON EITHER THE GAUGE OR THE CASE WHEN IN STORAGE. CONTRARY TO THIS, ON 6/2/2022, THE LICENSEE WAS STORING PORTABLE GAUGES WITHOUT A LOCK ON THE GAUGE OR THE CASE. THE LICENSEE IMMEDIATELY LOCKED THE GAUGE TRIGGERS AND COMMITTED TO INCLUDE THIS REQUIREMENT IN THE NEXT ANNUAL TRAINING.
