Dear Dr. Schwaderer:

It came to our attention that there was an error in your NRC Materials License No. 21-04081-03. The error initially occurred in Amendment No. 63 issued on September 27, 2019. In that amendment you were authorized to use Y-90 microspheres; however, we failed to amend Condition 10.A. of your license to reflect the authorized place of use for the Y-90 at 50 N. Perry St., Pontiac, Michigan. Unfortunately, the error was carried over to Amendment No. 64 issued on February 18, 2021. We have now corrected this error. Please find enclosed a Corrected Copy of Amendment No. 64 with changes to Condition 10 of the license. We apologize for any inconvenience this error may have caused.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.
