Dear Mr. Wainman:

This is to acknowledge receipt of the submitted NRC Form 314, "Certificate of Disposition of Materials," dated August 19, 2022, in which you identified the transfer/disposal of radioactive materials. Upon review, I identified the following areas requiring additional or clarifying information:

1. Item A, "License Status," of the above referenced form was not completed as required. Please clarify if it is your intention to terminate your license.
2. Your request identified that you contracted with the waste broker, Bionomics, Inc., to arrange for the transfer/disposal of licensed materials. It appears that your licensed materials were transferred to Bionomics, Inc., on August 9, 2022.

Please provide a letter from Bionomics, Inc., confirming receipt of your NDT Systems, Inc., Model 13640B Tube Wall Caliper into their inventory.

For your reference, the program specific guidance for your license is NUREG-1556, Volume 1, Rev. 2, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance About Portable Gauge Licenses," dated June 2016.
