- certificate of completion of a well logging RSO or authorized user's course or an

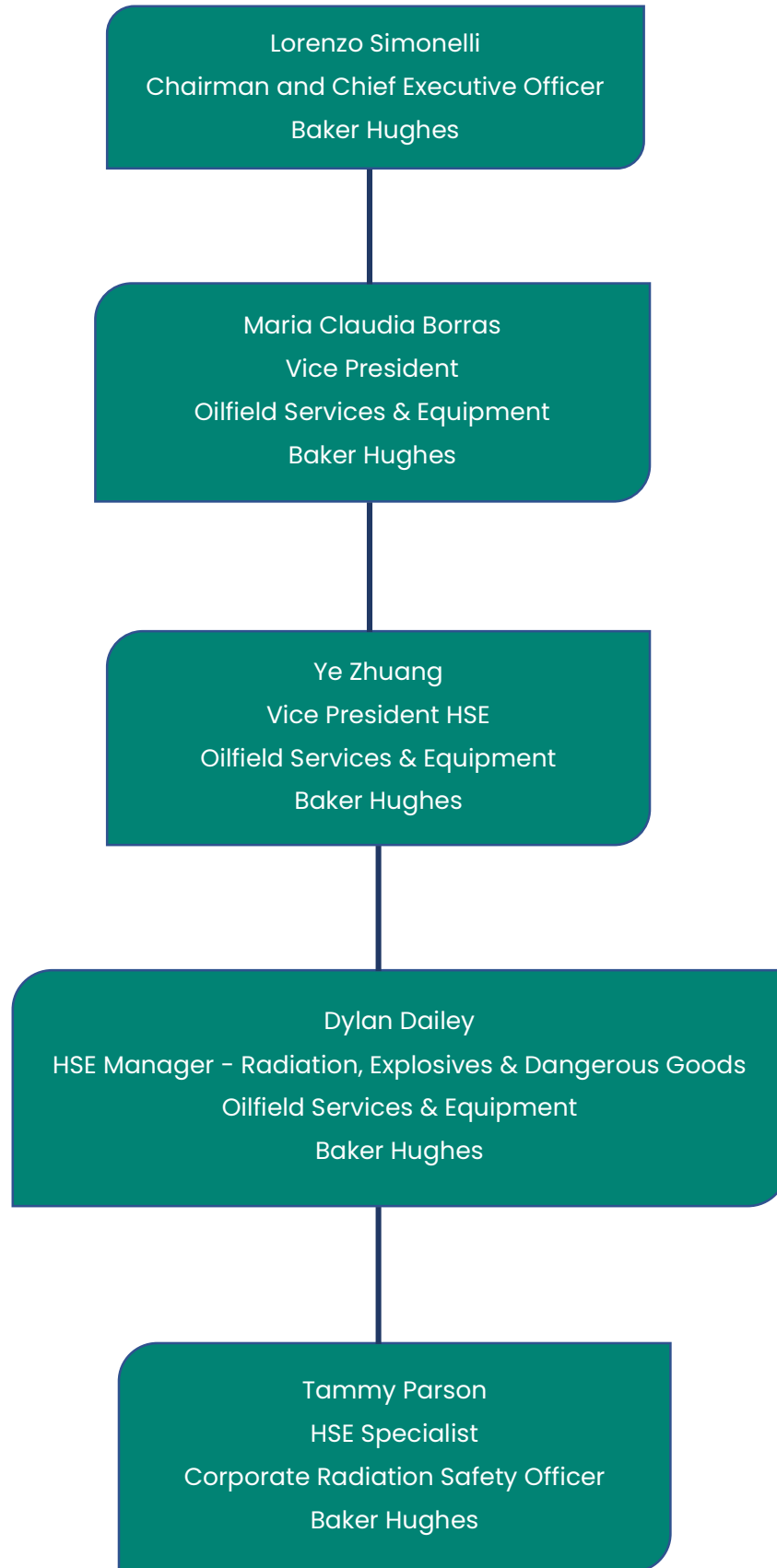
equivalent course that meets the logging supervisor criteria specified in Appendix F of this NUREG.

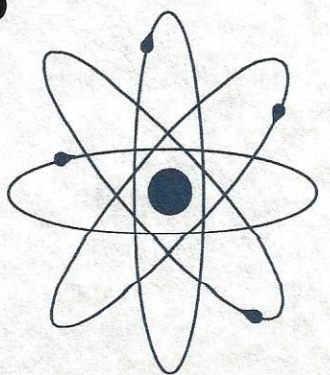
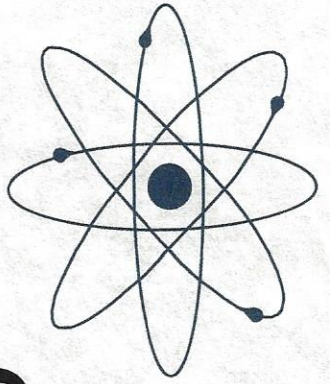


