Dear Chairman Hanson:

I write regarding the safety and security of NRC employees — which I know is a matter of utmost importance to NRC and NTEU. I am sure you are aware of the recent dangerous and false rhetoric by some politicians and others, targeting in particular the IRS, another of NTEU's represented agencies. However, NTEU is deeply concerned about all federal employees in this climate, and I write to you today to stand with us in support of them.

Our members are increasingly worried about their safety, and we ask that you immediately take steps to enhance security at NRC facilities nationwide and take measures to minimize placing employees in settings where they are at risk. Federal employees are often targeted due to the nature of their work, especially for those who work requires close interaction with the public. Too often in the past, we have seen anti-government, anti-worker statements fuel violent attacks on innocent federal employees. I was sickened to read a report of one political candidate who condoned shooting federal employees "on sight." These public servants are doing the job that Congress asked of them, and they deserve to be protected. I request that you perform a comprehensive review of safety and security measures at all of your facilities, including GSA-leased space that may share entries and common areas with other organizations and businesses which interact with the public.

The review should consider whether each facility has, among other things: the proper risk assessment security level designation; sufficient entry control systems, including guards or other armed presence and magnetometers; sufficient perimeter security; exterior lighting; proper designation of restricted areas; and operable security equipment. I wanted to share with you that we have asked the IRS to minimize the amount of field work by its employees because of the targeted and specific harmful statements circulating on news outlets and on social media which incite violence against federal employees. We certainly encourage whatever additional efforts you deem appropriate to help protect NRC's field employees in a similar manner.
