## **Materials Inspection Report (Continued)**

License Condition 12 of NRC license 04-35652-01E. Amendment No. 0, dated May 17, 2022, requires in part, that the licensee shall conduct its program in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in the documents, including any enclosures, listed in License Condition 12. License Condition 12A, Application dated August 18, 2021, provides an example of package labeling in Attachment 4b.

Attachment 4b, packaging example has the licensee's name and the byproduct material (Kr-85) used listed on the packaging.

Contrary to the above, between May 17, 2022, and August 23, 2022, the licensee failed to conduct its program in accordance with Application dated August 18, 2022, Attachment 4b. Specifically, the licensee failed to include in the label the byproduct material (Kr-85) contained in the product prior to distribution of the exempt product.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Enforcement Policy 6.3.d)

The licensee committed to preparing labels with the byproduct information (Kr-85) and placing on the product packaging prior to shipping to exempt customers until the manufacturer can correct the product labeling in accordance with the licensee's application submitted to the NRC dated August 18, 2021.
