LICENSEE:

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. The inspection findings are as follows:

- 1. Based on the inspection findings, no violations were identified.
- 2. Previous violation(s) closed.
- 3. The violation(s), specifically described to you by the inspector as non-cited violations, are not being cited because they were self-identified, non-repetitive, and corrective action was or is being taken, and the remaining criteria in the NRC Enforcement Policy, to exercise discretion, were satisfied.

- 4. During this inspection, certain of your activities, as described below and/or attached, were in violation of NRC requirements and are being cited in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy. A. 10 CFR 20.1101(c) requires in part that the licensee periodically (at least annually) review the radiation safety program content and implementation. Contrary to the above, from May 5, 2016, through February 23, 2022, the licensee did not perform any reviews the radiation safety program content and implementation.


The licensee committed to perform an audit within 30 days and set a reminder on their calendar to remind them of the requirement.

B. License condition 25 of NRC License No. 55-31040-01, requires in part that the licensee shall conduct a physical inventory every six months. Contrary to the above, from May 5, 2016, through February 23, 2022, the licensee did not conduct any physical inventories.

The licensee committed to perform an inventory within 30 days and set a reminder on their calendar to remind them of the requirement.

Statement of Corrective Actions

I hereby state that, within 30 days, the actions described by me to the Inspector will be taken to correct the violations identified. This statement of corrective actions is made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201 (corrective steps already taken, corrective steps which will be taken, date when full compliance will be achieved).
