This letter refers to an investigation conducted by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Office of Investigations (OI) to determine whether personnel at Exelon Corporation (Exelon)(now Constellation Energy Generation, LLC), Chicago, Illinois willfully discriminated against a former operations shift manager. Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, we did not substantiate the issue. The synopsis from the OI report of investigation is enclosed.

OI SYNOPSIS

This investigation was initiated by the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Office of Investigations (OI), Region III, Lisle, IL, on December 11, 2020, to determine whether personnel at Exelon Corporation (Exelon), Chicago, Illinois willfully discriminated against a former operations shift manager for raising nuclear safety concerns.

Based on the evidence developed, the allegation that Exelon discriminated against a former operations shift manager for raising nuclear safety concerns is not substantiated.
