This is in response to the October 11, 2022, letter (Agencywide Documents Access and Management Systems (ADAMS) Accession Number ML22306A206) from Mr. Bryant Hunt, Director Chemical Plant Operations, Honeywell Metropolis Works (Honeywell). In the letter, Mr. Hunt requested that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) confirm that Mr. Tyler Williamson, Human Resources Manager, can serve as reviewing official pursuant to NRC Order EA-07-086, "Order Imposing Fingerprinting and Criminal History Records Check Requirements for Unescorted Access to Radioactive Material or Other Property," dated April 30, 2007. Mr. Hunt also stated that fingerprints for Mr. Williamson had been previously transmitted to the NRC.

The NRC staff completed the review of the submittal and determined that Mr. Williamson meets the criteria specified in the Order. As such, Mr. Williams is approved and is, therefore, authorized to serve as a Honeywell reviewing official.

Reviewing officials must maintain and protect all fingerprints and Federal Bureau of Investigation criminal history records, other related records, and are authorized to grant access to Safeguards Information, as specified in the Order. Please note that, if Honeywell wishes to assign new or additional reviewing officials, the NRC must approve the individual(s) before they can serve in that position.

In accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*, Section 2.390, "Public inspections, exemptions, requests for withholding," of the NRC's "Agency Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this communication will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room, or from the NRC's ADAMS. The ADAMS database is accessible from the NRC website at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.
