THE MODEL NO. RT-100 PACKAGE – ACCEPTED FOR REVIEW

Dear Abdulsalam Shakhathreh:

By letter dated August 29, 2022 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML22262A264), as supplemented November 22, 2022 (ADAMS Accession No. ML22335A081), you submitted an application to revise Certificate of Compliance (CoC) No. 9365, for the Model No. RT-100 transport package. The application proposes to add activated hardware as new contents and provide flexibility to ship filters of varying activities. The staff performed an acceptance review of your application and determined the application contains sufficient technical information in scope and depth to allow the staff to complete a detailed technical review.

We have established a schedule for the review and estimated that the staff may need approximately 600 staff review hours. The schedule allows for the staff to issue a request for additional information (RAI) in March 2023 and, if a second RAI is not needed, a CoC in June 2023, based on you responding to the first RAI in April 2023. In general, no additional changes to the application should be submitted except for changes resulting from your response to an RAI.
