Dear Dr. Coon:

This is in reference to your application dated November 1, 2022, requesting to amend NRC License No. 07-31361-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information. Please note that the guidance for proposed changes of control may be found in NUREG-1556, Volume 15, Revision 1, "Guidance About Changes of Control and About Bankruptcy Involving Byproduct, Source, or Special Nuclear Materials Licenses" and may be found at <https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1556/v15/>. Licensees must provide full information and obtain NRC's prior written consent before transferring control of the license. Provide the following information concerning changes of control by the applicant (transferor and/or transferee, as appropriate). Please state if any items are not applicable. While many of these items were addressed in your initial application, certain specific commitments are sought from both parties. A single response with signatures from individuals from both parties with authority to make legally binding commitments is requested.

1. Describe any changes in the equipment, waste management, or emergency procedures that relate to the licensed program.
2. Confirm the following:

“Both transferor and transferee agree to transferring control of the licensed material and activity, and the conditions of transfer, and that the transferee has been made aware of any open inspection items and its responsibility for possible resulting enforcement actions.”
3. Confirm the following:

“The transferee will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the transferor or that the transferee will submit a complete description of the proposed licensed program.”
4. Confirm whether the proposed new majority owner, Blue River PetCare Group, LLC, (1) holds either an Agreement State or NRC radioactive materials license; or (2) is the parent company to an entity that holds either an Agreement State or NRC radioactive materials license.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at Jonathan.Pfingsten@nrc.gov.

In order to continue prompt review of your application, we request that you submit your response to this letter within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Agency Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's document system (ADAMS). ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web Site at: <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>. Please be aware that you may request that certain portions of your submittal to NRC be withheld from public disclosure as proprietary information. To do this, you must execute an affidavit as specified in 10 CFR 2.390. You must list all portions that you wish to be held proprietary, along with your reasoning as to why that is appropriate. While it is allowable, please refrain from submitting proprietary information in support of a license unless necessary. Keep in mind that all NRC licenses are considered to be in the public domain, and therefore may be viewed by any member of the public who requests to see them.
