
Dear Ms. Piskura,

We appreciate your time and attention to our NRC inspection at IU Health Arnett on November 15, 2022. Please accept our action plan based on the findings during this inspection regarding the ring badges that were cancelled:

1. Replacement ring badges were ordered on November 16, 2022 and scheduled to be express shipped for Dr. [redacted] Dr. [redacted] and Dr. [redacted] to replace what had been cancelled in February 2022.
2. Multiple attempts have been made to get in contact with Mirion by phone to get further information regarding who cancelled these badges and understand "why". Messages were left for Mirion with each attempt, with no return call received at this time.
3. All necessary information needed to calculate an extremity dose reconstruction for all Y-90 cases done from 2019-present was forwarded over to our physicist, Bryce Caudle on November 17, 2022 for that calculation to be done. We will forward on those calculations once we receive that report back.

As owner of IU Health Arnett's ALARA program and because our efforts to get in contact with Mirion have been unsuccessful, Danielle Owens, Director of Imaging Services is taking full responsibility for the cancellations of the ring badges of Dr. [redacted] Dr. [redacted] and Dr. [redacted]. Thorough evaluation of monthly reports and careful routine review of appropriate badge wearing will be conducted. This will allow for a quick identification should the issue arise again. In addition, it is our hope that this will also prevent any reoccurrence in the future.
