As described in the enclosed NRC Form 313, together with addendum and enclosures, WSP USA Environment & Infrastructure Inc. is requesting an amendment to the subject materials license. The subject license is a service provider's class of materials license issued to Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, Inc. authorizing the performance of a variety of characterization, remediation, and radiological decommissioning services at a customer's temporary job site. This license is not currently being implemented at any temporary job site.

On September 21, 2022, the shares of Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, Inc. were sold by John Wood Group PLC and purchased by WSP USA Inc. The entity formerly known as Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, Inc. (licensee) is now incorporated as **WSP USA Environment & Infrastructure Inc.**, as an indirectly controlled corporation of WSP Global Inc (parent company). The attached amendment request reflects the name change and other corresponding details relevant to the materials license. The program, procedures, and responsible leadership under which the subject license was issued and controlled have been adopted without revision or exception by WSP USA Environment & Infrastructure Inc. and remain in place.

Regarding the Change of Parent Company Indirect Control of Radioactive Materials License Number 7927-01, Amendment No. 10

Description of planned changes in the organization.

On September 21, 2022, the shares of Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, Inc., were sold by John Wood Group PLC and purchased by WSP USA Inc. The entity formerly known as Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, Inc. is now incorporated as **WSP USA Environment & Infrastructure Inc.** The licensee, Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, Inc., will transition from the indirect control of John Wood Group PLC to the control of WSP USA Inc.

- No changes to personnel, including the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO), or duties of the personnel, will change because of this change of parent company control. No changes will take place to the training program.
- No changes to the facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, use, possession, waste management, or other procedures that relate to the licensed program will result from this change of parent company control.
- Nothing regarding Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, Inc.'s radiation safety program, including facilities and equipment, will change because of this change of parent company control. Calibrations, leak tests, radiation surveys, training, quality control and related records are current, and no change will occur to the maintenance of these items.
- Both the transferor and transferee agree to transferring control of the licensed material and activities. The radioactive material service provider's license is not at this time invoked at any client's site and no radioactive materials other than company owned instrument calibration and response check sources are currently possessed under this license. There are no open inspection items associated with the subject license.
- WSP USA Environment & Infrastructure, Inc. will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the existing materials license.
- The subject license does not require a decommissioning funding plan nor a decommissioning financial assurance instrument.


