Dear Mr. Mumford:

This refers to your license amendment request dated August 3, 2022. Please find enclosed Amendment No. 27 authorizing Wael Abdalla, M.D., Jennifer Kucera, M.D., and Rahul Nikam, M.D. as Authorized Users and removing David Dinan, M.D., and Tejal Mody, M.D. as requested. Please note that the following changes were also made to your license:

- The authorized research use of Fluorine-18 as listed on your license was changed from research and development under 10 CFR 30.4 to human research under the provisions of 10 CFR 35.6 since you indicated all research conducted under this license is clinical and not benchtop or animal research.
- 2. The listings for microspheres were updated to reflect the current description in the Sealed Source and Device Registry.
- Condition 12B was removed as it is no longer necessary. Allison Aguado, M.D. completed the required three proctored cases by the TheraSphere vendor on December 18, 2017, October 29, 2018, and February 11, 2021.

An environmental assessment for this action was not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license.
