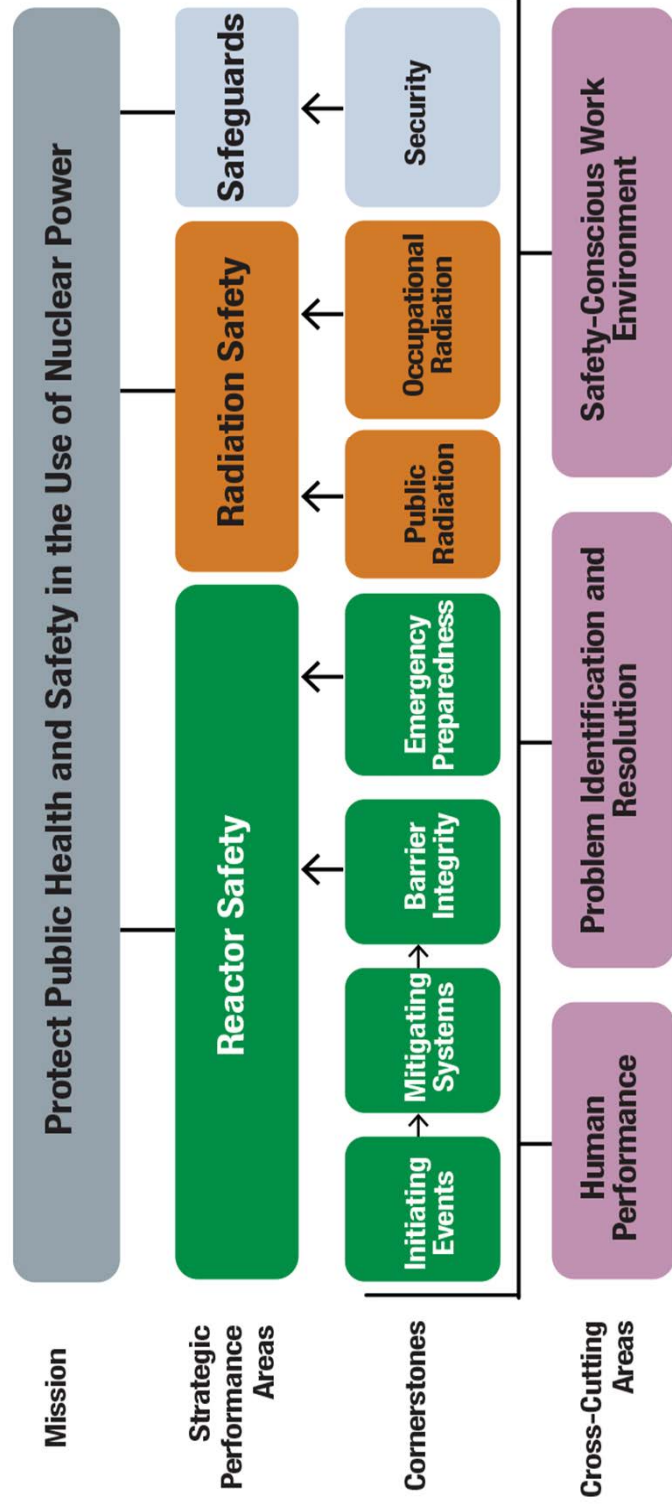

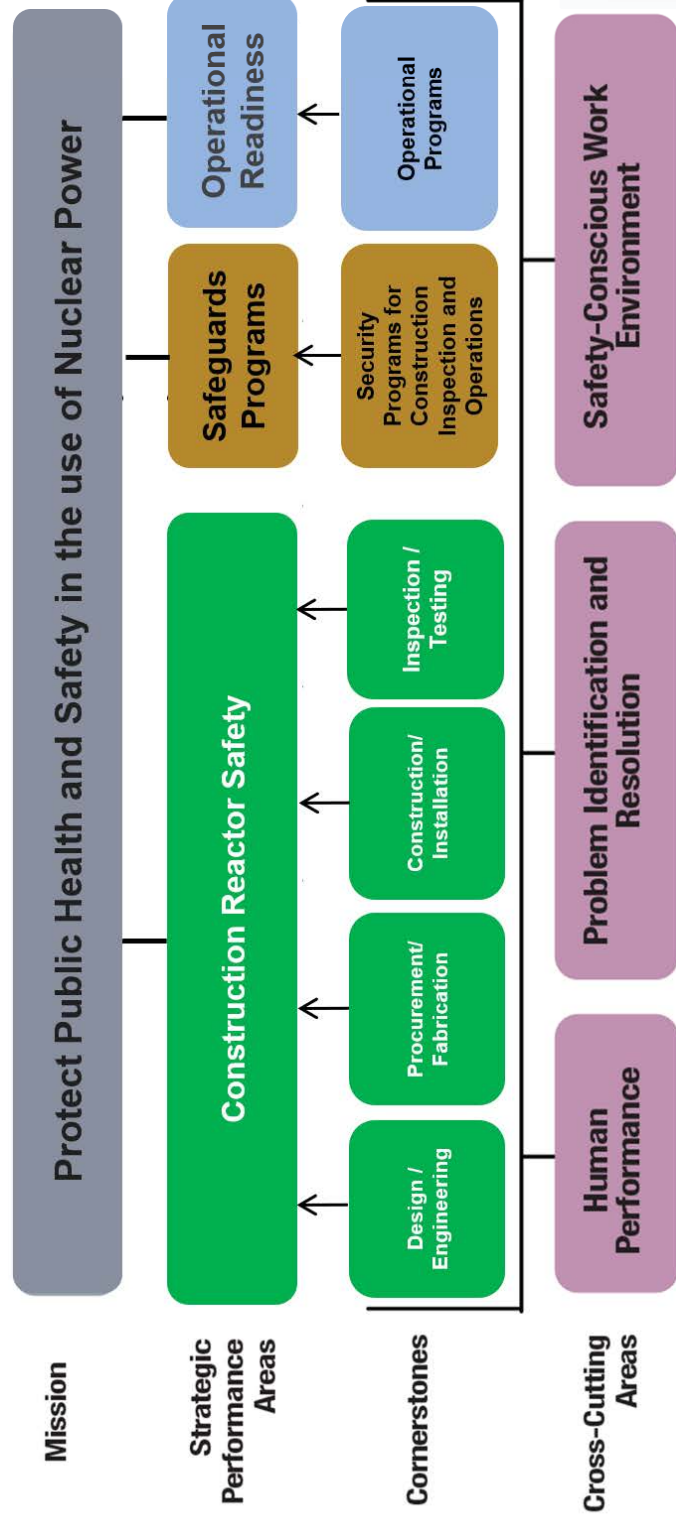

Resident Inspector Program – Vogtle Units 1-4

- Live in the community and work at the nuclear sites and respond to plant events
- Provide daily coverage and oversight of plant activities for both construction and operating sites
- Prioritize inspections based on important plant activities
- Routinely discuss safety concerns plant management
- Support NRC allegation process for plant employees and the public

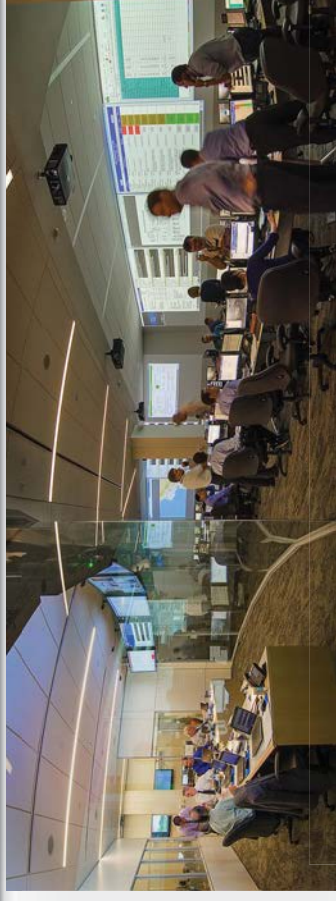

Resident Inspector Program – Vogtle Units 1-4

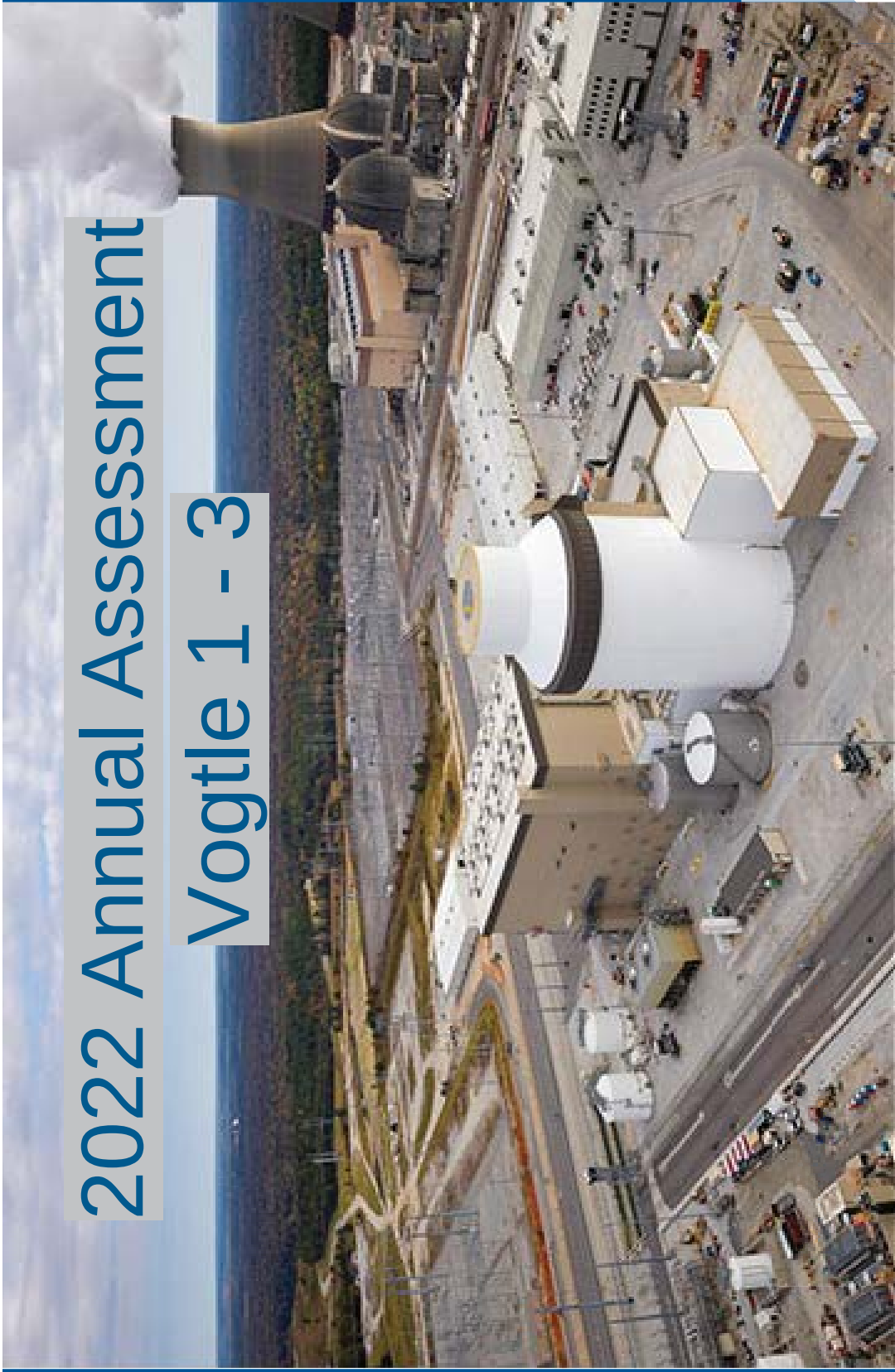
- ROP
 - Conduct the baseline inspections
 - Observe emergency exercises and provide support for any real emergencies or urgent issues
- cROP
 - ITAAC inspections
 - Initial Test Program inspections
 - Operational Programs inspections

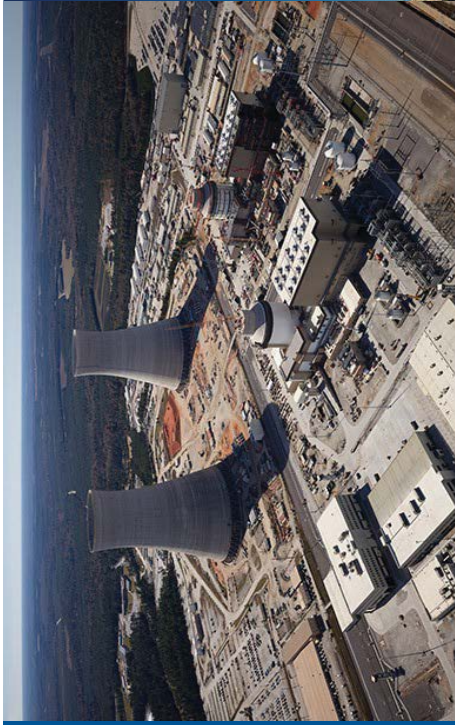

Annual Assessment Summary

- Southern Nuclear Company operated the Vogtle Nuclear Plant Units 1-3 safely and in a manner that preserved the public health and safety and protected the environment.
- Vogtle Units 1, 2, and 3 were in the **Licensee Response Column** of the NRC's ROP Action Matrix for the last quarter of 2022.
 - Performance Indicators were Green (no performance thresholds exceeded)
 - Units 1 & 2: Six Green non-cited violations
 - Unit 3: Two Green non-cited violations
- NRC plans to conduct routine baseline inspections for 2023

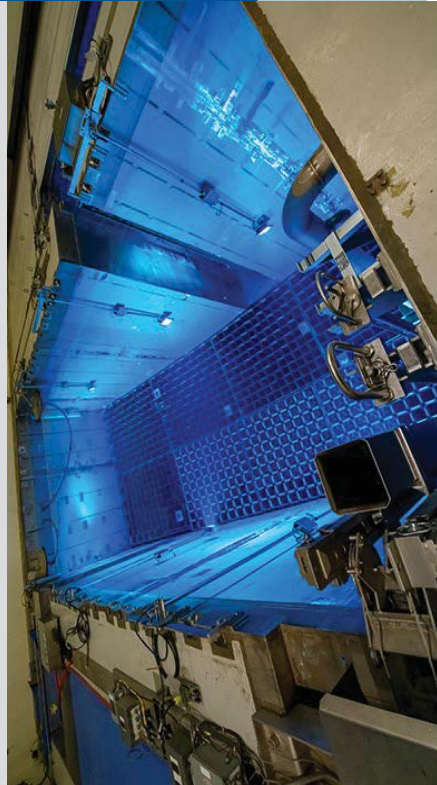

Annual Assessment Summary

- Southern Nuclear Company constructed Vogtle Nuclear Plant Unit 4 safely and in a manner that preserved the public health and safety and protected the environment.
- Vogtle Unit 4 was in the **Licensee Response Column** of the NRC's cROP Action Matrix for the last quarter of 2022.
 - Unit 4: Four Findings of very low safety significance (Green)
- NRC plans to conduct routine baseline inspections for 2023

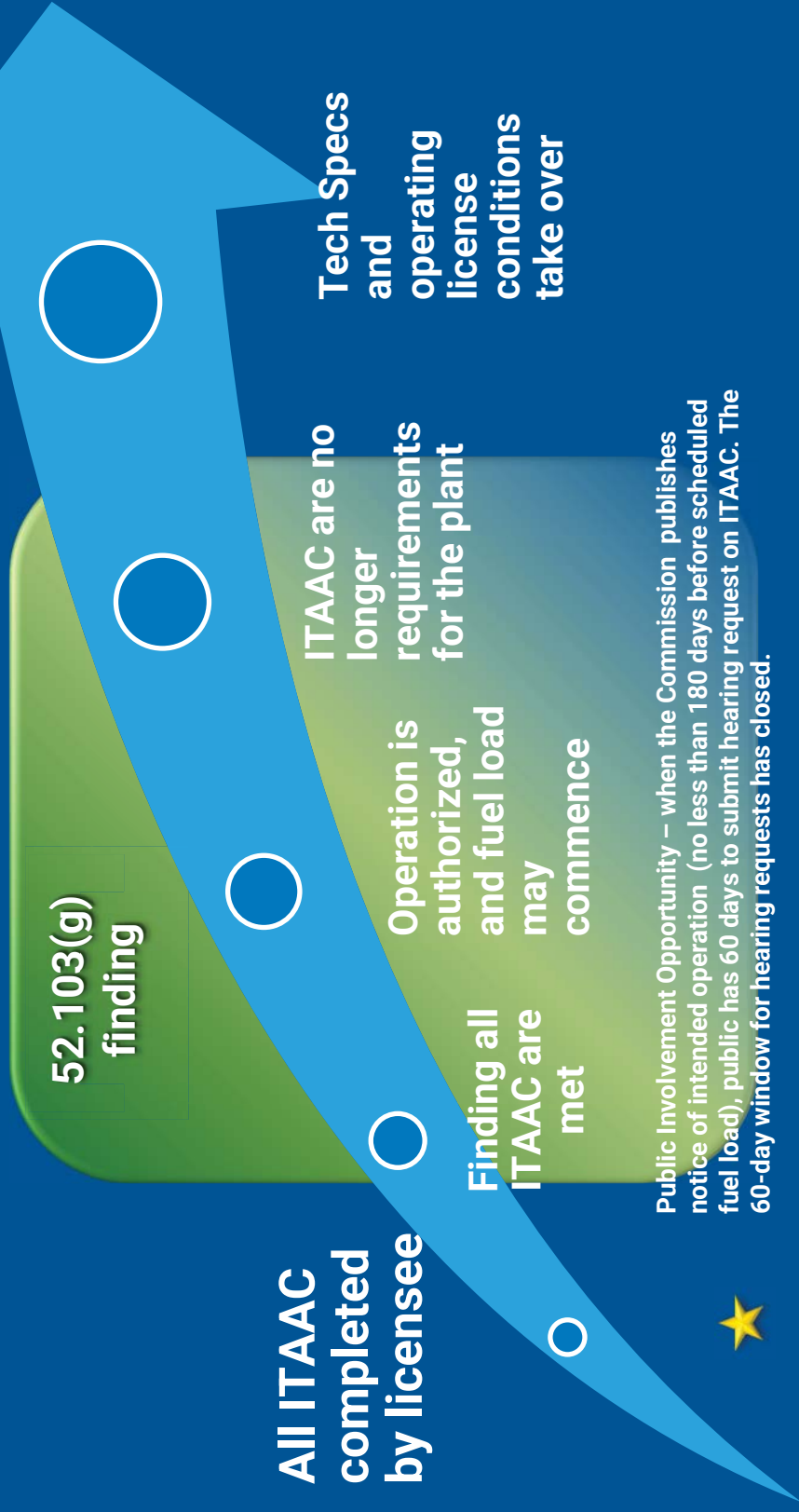
