Response to NRC for Supplemental Information to Complete Acceptance Review

On December 2nd, 2022 Cammenga and Associates, LLC ("Cammenga") submitted an amendment package to the NRC (Accession Number ML22342A039) to amend its Glass Breaker (GB) Series of devices. On April 19th, 2023 Cammenga received a letter from the NRC requesting supplemental information in order to complete its acceptance review.

The below information are the answers to the NRC's inquiries.

1. The NRC's concern with this acceptance review seems to be focused on two main factors to determine whether the new model in the GB Series should be determined as "frivolous" under 10 CFR 32.33 and 10 CFR 30.19(c):
 - What is the intended use of the device(s)?
 - Is the applied for device a finished product?

The devices in the 1C-xG follow the same intended uses as the other approved devices in the GB Series – the primary function is to break glass.

The devices in the 1C-xG amendment package are finished products and do not require other components in order to serve their primary function.

2. Just as the other approved devices in the GB Series, the intended use of the 1C-xG devices is to break glass. These devices do not require any other components to serve their primary function. These devices are not intended to be used in conjunction with another object to break glass.
