Dear Mr. Welch:

This letter is in response to Air Products and Controls, Inc. d/b/a Apollo America application dated March 31, 2023, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) requesting the termination of your Exempt Distribution Radioactive Materials License Numbers 21-23805-01 and 21-23805-02E. The NRC staff has reviewed your termination application and determined that additional information is required to complete the process.

Your request to terminate your license standards containing byproduct material for distribution is regulated under Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 30, "Rules of General Applicability to Domestic Licensing of Byproduct Material". The regulations require the applicant to submit sufficient information on the product to evaluate compliance, please submit the requested information listed below.

1. The applicant must provide the last 12 months transfer report. If no transfer of byproducts has taken place (not including waste disposal), then the report must so indicate.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, "Agency Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records component of NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS). ADAMS is accessible from the NRC website at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>. You may request that certain portions of your submittal to the NRC be withheld from public disclosure as proprietary information. To do this, you must execute an affidavit as specified in 10 CFR 2.390. You must list all portions that you wish to be withheld as proprietary, along with your reasoning as to why that is appropriate.

To continue the review of your application, Air Products and Controls, Inc. must submit the requested information within 30 calendar days of the date of this letter. In your response, please reference the license, docket, and control numbers specified below. If we have not received your response within 30 calendar days, we will consider your request as having been abandoned by you. In the future, Air Products and Controls, Inc. is encouraged to submit a completely new request without bias.
