Frank Aguirre, RSO:

The NRC has received your amendment request to change the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) in NRC license number 04-23264-01 from yourself to Andy Hall and additional information is needed. Please provide the following information in a signed and dated letter in pdf format by reply email within 30 days from receipt of this email.

1. Demonstrate that the RSO has sufficient independence and direct communication with responsible management officials by providing a copy of an organizational chart by position and demonstrating day-to-day oversight of the radiation safety activities.
2. Confirm that the RSO will be available for emergencies and can be on-site within 24-48 hours, if applicable.
3. Provide the specific training and experience of the RSO, and include the specific dates of training in radiation safety.
4. Provide alternative information demonstrating that the proposed RSO is qualified by training and experience (e.g., Board Certification by the American Board of Health Physicists, completion of a bachelor's and/or master's degree in the sciences with at least one year of experience in the conduct of a radiation safety program of comparable size and scope).
5. NRC license number 04-23264-01 shows the licensee as "NDC Technologies, Inc." while the amendment request letter dated April 25, 2023 has a letterhead and a signature block stating "Nordson Measurement & Control". Indicate if a transfer of control or change of ownership had occurred involving activities under NRC license number 04-23264-01. The document titled "NUREG-1556, Volume 15, Revision 1" provides guidance on transfer of control in Appendixes B, C, D and E.  - A. If a transfer of control or change of ownership had occurred, submit the information described in Appendix E of NUREG-1556, Volume 15, Revision 1, in a signed and dated letter (letter needs to be signed and dated by both parties: transferee and transferor). In addition, the company acquiring the NRC license needs to provide a document issued by State or Federal government demonstrating that the company is legitimate (example: NRC or Agreement State radioactive materials license, other permits, or authorizations issued by a State government or Federal government).
