SCHEDULING ORDER

(Rescheduling Oral Argument on Standing and Contention Admissibility)

The oral argument that was originally scheduled for May 24, 2023,¹ but that was postponed due to unforeseen exigent circumstances,² will be held on Tuesday, June 13, 2023, beginning at 1:00 p.m. Eastern Time (ET). The oral argument will address standing and contention admissibility issues presented in the hearing request filed by San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace (SLOMFP) seeking to intervene in Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E's) application to renew its license for the independent spent fuel storage installation at the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant.³

Consistent with the initial Scheduling Order, <u>see supra</u> note 1, the June 13, 2023 oral argument will be held in-person in the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel's Hearing
