Addendum to 2021 Decommissioning Funding Status Reports / Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) Financial Assurance Update

Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) is the sole owner of Turkey Point Units 3 and 4 and St. Lucie Unit 1. FPL, Florida Municipal Power Agency, and Orlando Utilities Commission own St. Lucie Unit 2. NextEra Energy Seabrook, LLC, Hudson Light and Power Department, Massachusetts Municipal Wholesale Electric Company, and Taunton Municipal Lighting Plant own Seabrook Station. This letter provides an addendum to the 2021 ISFSI decommissioning funding updates for Turkey Point, St. Lucie, and Seabrook Station for FPL and on behalf of NextEra Energy Seabrook, LLC and the joint owners of the above-referenced plants.

The 2021 NextEra ISFSI Decommissioning Financial Assurance Update included new ISFSI decommissioning cost estimates for Turkey Point, St. Lucie, and Seabrook. For this reason, NextEra did not include updates to those new cost studies. But for completeness, the following tables supplement each decommissioning funding study to address new information that may affect the previously submitted reports in accordance with 10 CFR 72.30(c)(1-4) between the finalization of the cost studies and the March 30, 2021 letter.
