Reference is to Release No. N 227-AEC  
IMPLEMENTS PRACTICAL VALUE LEGISLATION- the issue of  
antitrust has as much impact on the public as  
radiological safety matters; it is my understanding  
that the AEC is more objective than the public in  
safety matters and the public can leave such consider-  
ations to you for determination; however the matter of  
anti-trust can result in the loss of millions of  
jobs and the loss of industry to the USA and notice in  
the Federal Register is inadequate to give notice of  
anti-trust considerations.

I cant conceive of anti-trust matters being  
inappropriate for hearings in the public interest.  
I would like to suggest that the AEC be required to  
place such notices in the Traffic World and The  
New York Times Syndicate- for New York, Chicago and  
Los Angeles.

With the 18 yearold vote coming up for the  
next Congressional election- I think they should have  
notice of anti-trust considerations in plants and  
servicing of them; especially in the possible exporting  
of jobs and importing of components. They cant get  
adequate notice in the Federal Register.

I own property and will authorize the building  
of atomic plants anywhere in the area of my property  
under the safety supervision of the AEC; however I  
think the electorate should have actual knowledge of  
anti-trust factors involved in plants.
