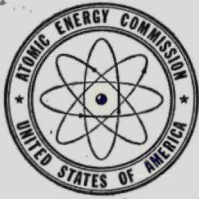

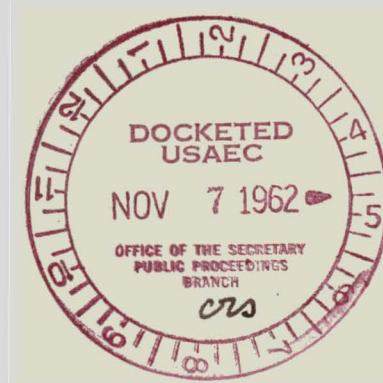
Dear Mr. Karp:
