PART I.D -- COMMENTS

This response also serves to acknowledge receipt of your May 31, 2023 request.

Over the years, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has received requests for records relating to to the Manhattan Project. As part of the processing of those previous requests, this office conferred with the NRC Historian, who told us that the NRC does not have records relating to the Manhattan Project. Rather, records associated with the Manhattan Project would fall under the auspices of the Department of Energy (DOE). We appreciate that you have already submitted a FOIA request to DOE; however, DOE's response did not include references to two websites that may hold information of interest to you: https://www.energy.gov/sites/prod/files/2014/04/f15/Evolution_History_DOE_042314.pdf, and <https://www.energy.gov/lm/manhattan-project-historical-resources>.

Moreover, a search of the Main and Legacy Libraries of the NRC's official recordkeeping repository, Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), <https://adams.nrc.gov/wba/>, did not turn up any records when we searched for records relating to the named individual.
