Dear Mr. Gilbert:

This letter is in response to Teledyne Defense Electronics, LLC d/b/a Teledyne Reynolds (Teledyne Reynolds) application dated May 17, 2023, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) requesting the renewal of your Exempt Distribution Radioactive Materials License NRC 04-16982-01E. The NRC staff has reviewed your renewal application and determined that additional information is required to complete our review.

To continue with our review, please address the issues listed below. This information is required by Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Sections 32.14 and described in the relevant guidance document NUREG-1556, Volume 8, Revision 1, titled "Program-Specific Guidance About Exempt Distribution Licenses."

1. Provide a copy of your possession license.
2. Provide the construction and design of each product.
3. Provide the method of containment or binding of byproduct material in the product.
4. Provide the proposed method of labeling or marking.
5. Provide the specific radiation levels and the methods of measurement for each container or cylinder.
6. Provide information that each product will contain no more than the quantity of byproduct material specified for that product in 10 CFR 30.15.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, "Public inspections, exemptions, request for withholding," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records component of NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS). ADAMS is accessible from the NRC website at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>. You may request that certain portions of your submittal to the NRC be withheld from public disclosure as proprietary information. To do this, you must execute an affidavit as specified in 10 CFR 2.390. You must list all portions that you wish to be withheld as proprietary, along with your reasoning as to why that is appropriate.

To continue the review of your application, Teledyne Reynolds must submit the requested information within 30 calendar days of the date of this letter. In your response, please reference the license, docket, and control numbers specified below. If we have not received your response within 30 calendar days, we will consider your request as having been abandoned by you. In the future, Teledyne Reynolds is encouraged to submit a completely new request without bias.
